## VMTA Theory, Sight Reading, and Skills Tests

The VMTA Theory, Sight Reading, and Keyboard Skills Tests will be held in the afternoon on Sunday, March 1, 2015. The postmark deadline is set for January 31st.

The tests will be held at VCU in the Singleton Center for the Performing Arts and the James Black Music Center. If a student is taking tests in two different buildings, a parent must be available to escort the student to the appropriate building. Parents should be told to wait in the lobby while the student is taking a test.

Exact testing times will be scheduled once applications are received. Remember, any application received AFTER the postmark deadline WILL NOT be accepted. Please make sure the application is correct before submission.

Fees are \$12 per test. All other details are found in the RMTA Yearbook. Remember that sample written and listening tests for theory are found on the VMTA and RMTA members area of the website. These can be great resources to help prepare your students.
