The recipient of the RMTA Collegiate Chapter VCU Scholarship this year is Lanjiabao Ge. She will be receiving a \$1000 tuition scholarship, the funding of which came directly from our student Playathon. Ms. Ge is currently a Junior piano major student studying with Dr. Yin Zheng. She won second place in 2013 and HM in 2014 in the MTNA piano competitions, as well as both first place prizes in the Sigma Alpha Iota Scholarship Competitions. She also won first place in the Washington, D.C. Alumni Chapter of Mu Phi Epsilon Scholarship competition, and is the accompanist for the VCU Dance department and the Richmond Ballet. She has also won numerous competitions in China and Germany. In her words, "To me, playing music is like the color of the beautiful four seasons. There's the hopeful spring, vibrant summer, the melancholic autumn, and the noble and lonely winter. I pour my heart into the music I create, and I always want to share this passion with my audience."

Ms. Ge is spoken of very highly as a pianist, and we are happy to award her the Collegiate Chapter Scholarship, even though the chapter has not been active this year. We hope she will take an active role in the Collegiate Chapter next year. We have created a new RMTA position called Collegiate Chapter Liaison, and Savannah Hatcher will be the Chair. The purpose of this liaison is to assist and advise the VCU MTNA Collegiate Chapter on their activities. We are hopeful that having an RMTA liaison with the Collegiate Chapter will ensure a more active chapter.

Ms. Ge has volunteered to perform for RMTA for our September 19th meeting and potluck. We are happy to have the opportunity to meet her and get to know her. RMTA will be sending a \$1000 check to VCU directly, to apply towards her tuition. We sent her our congratulations on her award, and she sent us her sincere gratitude. Dr. Zheng and Dr. Harper of VCU also sent us their thanks.
